STOP CYBER CRIMINALS IN THEIR TRACKS!

FASNY Federal Credit Union wants to keep you informed and equip you with the knowledge to stay safe. Take a moment to read these guidelines to ensure your personal information remains protected.

- Store critical financial documents in a secure and locked location. Shred documents containing sensitive information before discarding them
- Avoid using public computers or shared devices to access your credit union account, as they might have malware or keyloggers installed
- Fraudsters use tactics to mimic FASNY Federal Credit Union, often making it seem like their call or text is coming from us on your caller ID. Always be cautious if you receive a call or text that appears to be from us
- They ask for sensitive details like your account number, credit/debit card information, or personal identification. This is a definite warning sign
- Remember that we will never contact you via phone or text to request specific personal financial or account information. Our team members will only ask you to verify such details when YOU initiate the call
